CHRYSEIA PUTS DOURO WINES ON TOP OF THE WORLD

The Chryseia 2011 Douro DOC has been placed in Wine Spectator Magazine's prestigious 'TOP 10' ranking of the world's finest wines, earning the number 3 slot, alongside two other wines from the Douro — a Vintage Port and another Douro dry red wine.

It is not the first time that Chryseia has made history: in the 2003 edition of the annual TOP 100 Classification by Wine Spectator, the Chryseia 2001 became the first Portuguese wine (non-fortified) ever to enter this ranking. At the time, the Chryseia 2001 scored 94 points and drew the attention of the world to the potential of the wines of the Douro region. Now, a decade later, the Chryseia 2011 – with a score of 97 points – has once again placed the Douro and Portugal in the forefront of global attention.

For the partnership of Prats & Symington, which brings together the *savoir-faire* of Frenchman Bruno Prats with the Symington family's deep understanding of the *terroir* of the Douro region, this achievement is a watershed in a journey that has contributed enormously to the reputation of the wines of the region. This success was further underpinned following the acquisition of the emblematic Quinta de Roriz, which has been a principal component of Chryseia since 2009.
