... evidence from the last few vintages shows the winery is now a force to be reckoned with. SOLdeSOL from Traiguén, 400 miles south of Santiago is Chilean Chardonnay at its most elegant. Lazuli Cabernet is even better. 2003 mixes cassis and olive flavours with a Mediterranean-like dustiness and hints of pencil lead and mint, and finishes spicy, stylish fashion. Drink 2007 - 2013
